Working under the direction and supervision of the Superintendent of Public Works, the laborer performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks in the maintenance and repair of Borough roads, storm and sanitary sewer systems, sanitation collection, parks and other public work facilities, and other manual tasks as required. Duties include but are not limited to: Operate a variety powered machinery including weed whackers, lawn mowers, and heavy equipment. Collect and remove litter from roadside or Borough properties. Maintain streets, parking lots, and related property. Maintain parks, grounds, and related facilities. Perform general maintenance and custodial duties to prepare facilities for public use. Perform a wide range of tasks to maintain the operations of Public Works at the verbal or written direction of the Public Works Superintendent and/or designee. Physical demands include lifting, carrying, and/or moving up to 50 lbs. repeatedly – occasionally up to 100 lbs. The duties listed above are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position. A strong background in a trade profession is a plus. This position is subject to federal regulations on CDL drug and alcohol testing. Employees work in adverse weather conditions and will be required to work overtime and be subject to call in for emergencies. Participation in annual snow removal is mandatory. Individuals must possess a valid commercial driver's license (CDL class B) issued by the State of New Jersey with applicable endorsements for types of vehicles used within one year of hire.
