**February 1<sup>st</sup>** Denis Niland from the Division of Consumer Affairs did a presentation on *Protecting Yourself in the Retail World*.



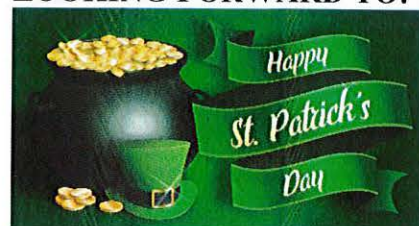
