BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 25, 2024
4:00 PM**

CALL TO ORDER

Notice of this meeting, in accordance with the "Open Public Meetings Law, 1975, C. "231", was posted at the Borough Hall, and two newspapers, The Record and The Ridgewood News, were notified.

ROLL CALL

John Frey, President, asked for a roll call. Members John Frey, Josephine Higgins, Ina Palatnek, Dr. Steven Sperber, Raphael Maurrasse and Dr. Mary Clark were present. Board of Health Secretary Debbie Dakin and Kristin Caperino from the Bergen County Board of Health were also present. Michelle Micali and Mary Clark were absent.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION to approve the Minutes of February 27, 2024, was made by Josephine Higgins, second by Raphael Maurrasse and approved by John Frey, Josephine Higgins, Dr. Steven Sperber, Raphael Maurrasse, and Ina Palatnek. Dr. Mary Clark abstained.

SANITARIAN'S REPORT

Kristin Caperino from Bergen County went over the inspection reports for February, March, April, and May 2024. Ms. Caperino stated that Bareburger had a conditional inspection in January and had 2 weeks to correct the problem. This was a critical violation, and they corrected it. Ms. Caperino stated that there was a complaint from a former resident at Sunrise stating that hair nets and gloves were not being worn. There were no violations when inspected. Dr. Sperber asked what happened at the Old Mill Pool regarding the water tests. Ms. Caperino replied that at the time of the inspection the water results were not in yet. Everything was good for the opening of the pool.

MOTION to approve the Sanitarian's Reports was made by John Frey, second by Josephine Higgins and unanimously approved.

- Animal Control Reports

Members went over the Animal Control reports for February, March, April, and May 2024. John Frey stated that there are a lot of coyotes in the past few months. Otherwise, it was quiet.

MOTION to approve the Animal Control Reports was made by Ina Palatnek, second by Raphael Maurrasse and unanimously approved.

- Water Reports

John Frey stated that he spoke with Chris O'Leary at Park Ridge Water regarding the wells. Park Ridge is monitoring the situation. Ms. Palatnek asked what is going to happen with all the future development in Woodcliff Lake. Dr. Clark asked who looks into the situation regarding water and traffic with future development. Ms. Palatnek asked if the Board of Health could write a letter to Park Ridge Water. It was suggested that the Borough Attorney write a letter, not the Board of Health. John Frey stated that he will follow up with Chris O'Leary.

MOTION to open to the public was made by Josephine Higgins, second by Ina Palatnek and unanimously approved.
