CALL TO ORDER

Notice of this meeting in accordance with the "Open Public Meetings Law, 1975, C. "231" was posted at Borough Hall and two newspapers, The Record and The Ridgewood News, were notified.

Mayor Carlos Rendo asked for roll call. Council members Brodsky, Gadaleta, Margolis, Marsh, Pollack, and Stern were present. John Schettino, Borough Attorney, Tomas Padilla, Borough Administrator and Debbie Dakin, Borough Clerk were present as well.

PUBLIC COMMENT

(limited to 3 minutes per speaker)

MOTION to open to the public was made by Councilwoman Gadaleta, second by Council President Pollack and unanimously approved.

Pete Gadaleta, Woodcliff Lake, stated that Councilwoman Gadaleta and himself moved to Woodcliff Lake 32 years ago. One day there was a message from former Mayor Goldsmith. Pete asked Jacquie what the message was about, and she replied, "tell you later". She told him that he asked her to run for Council. Pete asked Jacquie if she was going to do it and she stated yes. She won that term by 2 votes and went on for another and another, etc. Pete said that she taught her daughters how to get out of their comfort zone and that Jacquie truly enjoyed working with all the different departments and doing things for the betterment of Woodcliff Lake. He is very happy that she is going out on her terms.

MOTION to close to the public was made by Councilwoman Gadaleta, second by Council President Pollack and unanimously approved.

MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT

Appointment of Anthony Fava as a Member of the Woodcliff Lake Volunteer Fire Department

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Rendo stated that the New Jersey Turnpike Authority supports the Borough's position not to open Exit 171. This is a benefit to our residents. Mayor Rendo stated that he does not understand why Montvale took on this fight when it was not their fight to take on.

PRESENTATION OF PLAQUE TO OUTGOING COUNCIL MEMBER

Mayor Rendo presented a plaque to Councilwoman Jacqueline Gadaleta. Mayor Rendo stated that he enjoyed working with Jacquie and he is sorry to see her go. Even though they are both on different political sides of the aisle, they worked well together.

OUTGOING COUNCIL MEMBER'S STATEMENT

Councilwoman Gadaleta stated that her husband, Pepe, took a bit of what she was going to say. Councilwoman Gadaleta stated that her background is in finance and accounting. She was a girl scout leader, and she taught CCD. She asked why Mayor Goldsmith wanted her to run for Council and he stated for all those reasons. Councilwoman Gadaleta stated that she is so appreciative of working with everyone and it was the best experience she could have. She thanked her family for their support over the years and thanks all the residents who voted for her over the years.

Councilwoman Margolis stated that it was a pleasure working with Jacquie and running with her.

Residents never had a bad word to say about Councilwoman Gadaleta. This year when she walked door to door, residents asked where Jacquie was. The Council is going to miss all this history that Councilwoman Gadaleta provided.

Council President Pollack stated that she will be missed a lot on Council, and he thanked her for her guidance and support over the years. It was definitely a pleasure working with her.

COUNCIL MEMBERS' REPORTS

Councilwoman Gadaleta thanked the new volunteer for the fire department. She encourages all to come down to the fire department on a Thursday night and see what it is all about. Leaf collection ends today, and residents have until December 31st to bring the leaves to the ecology center. Bulk pick-up will start in January so please check on the website for the calendar. Christmas tree can be put out beginning December 26th and it will end on January 31st. They should be left near the curb with NO plastic bag. Councilwoman Gadaleta wishes Chris Behrens and Tom Torpey the best in their retirement.

Councilwoman Margolis stated that the Menorah lighting will take place on December 26th at Tice's Mall at 5PM. The Borough placed second place at the Van Saun Park Tree Lighting for our idea. We won a free skating session at Van Saun Park and the date is yet to be determined. We have leftover hot chocolate from the tree lighting so the police department will be hosting coco with a cop, and they are looking forward to working on that. The fire department will have their Chili Cook-off on February 2nd. They will be providing t-shirts for this event. Community Day with Woodcliff Lake United will take place in March next year. Our Easter Eggstravaganza will take place on April 16th. The fire department is thinking about hosting a National Night Out in August. They had done this event years ago and then a lot of residents went out of town, so they are thinking about bringing it back again.

Councilwoman Marsh stated that the Land Uses Board will have a meeting tomorrow night at Borough Hall at 7PM regarding 240 Broadway. It will likely go for a vote tomorrow. Please come out and speak about any opinion you might have regarding the project. The only way for the Board to know how residents feel is for them to come forward and speak at the meeting. Revisions for this application are on our website.

Councilman Stern stated that the Borough received notice from Montvale stating that Montvale's intention is to withdraw from the 2023 Shared Services Agreement between Montvale, Park Ridge, and Woodcliff Lake from the Pascack Joint Municipal Court. Mayor Rendo stated that Mayor Misciagna and himself met with Mayor Ghassali in Atlantic City at the League of Municipalities and he never said a word to them about this. We are reaching out to Park Ridge and other towns to inquire about a shared service for court. Councilwoman Stern stated that he believes that Woodcliff Lake should vote tonight to give Notice of Withdrawal from the 2023 Shared Services Agreement. He believes that it may no longer be in Woodcliff Lake's best interest to continue its membership of the Joint Court, and we should seek other alternatives. The resolution would be subject to consultation with the Mayor of Park Ridge.

Councilman Stern stated that Mayor Ghassali put out a petition regarding Exit 171 and stated that 50% of the residents of Woodcliff Lake and Park Ridge signed the petition. After an OPRA was filed for the petition, it was determined that 70 people from Woodcliff Lake signed the petition. Most of the people are from out of state.

Mayor Rendo stated that he thinks we should stay with Park Ridge. Park Ridge stated that they have the facilities to have a court. Mayor Rendo asked Councilman Stern and Councilwoman Marsh meet with Park Ridge on this matter. Mayor Rendo stated that the Joint Court worked fine and the way this happened was just not right.

Councilwoman Brodsky stated that she attended the Fifth District "Hometown Heroes" Awards with Congressman Josh Gottheimer to honor Jennifer Charnow, our Stigma Free Coordinator. We are very lucky to have Jennifer in our town and we thank her for all she brings to our community. The newsletter was sent out via email. If you have not received it and wish to get it, please go to our website, and subscribe.

Council President Pollack stated that we received a notice regarding the drones. There has been an influx of potential drone sitings in New Jersey. Veolia has put out a notice that they will be doing a deer inventory on Wednesday from 7PM to 3AM via a drone. They stated that there will be only one drone for this study. Council President Pollack thanked the Mayor and Council for a great year as Council President. He believes it was a very productive year, and he looks forward to next year.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Administration Padilla stated that we have a few Resolutions on the Agenda for new hires. After this hire for DPW, this will bring our number up to 11 employees for DPW. There is a Resolution on for a new account at ConnectOne for escrow. This will be an account for escrow going forward. We are trying to close out as many escrow accounts as possible at TD Bank.

Councilwoman Marsh stated that she needs to recuse herself from Resolution No. 24-291.

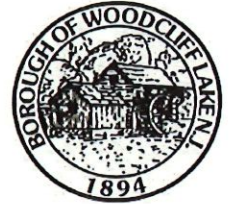

**DECEMBER 2024 ENGINEERS REPORT
BOROUGH OF WOODCLIFF LAKE
DECEMBER 12, 2024**



1. Glen Road Bridge (NJDOT & Municipal Funded)

NJDOT Grant project closeout documentation has been submitted to the NJDOT and is under review by the NJDOT for final reimbursement.

Supplemental erosion control work is being completed by Sanzari in accordance with Begeen County Co-Op contract to address the erosion and safety concern with the adjacent roadway from the August 3, 2024 cloudburst storm. This work is anticipated to be completed within the next 1-2 weeks including final restoration.

2. Glen Road Improvements Project NJDOT FY 2022

The Borough of Woodcliff Lake received a grant in the amount of \$206,000.00 from the NJDOT to be utilized towards the repaving of a portion Glen Road. Bids opened on 8/9/2023 and the project was awarded to Macchione Paving as per resolution no. 23-186 for \$239,937.75. Paving was completed, NJDOT inspection completed, and asphalt core testing was completed and acceptable. Maintenance Bond and Borough closeout package provided to the Borough on 12/2/2024. NJDOT closeout package for final reimbursement to be submitted to the NJDOT following Borough closeout.

3. Werimus Lane Bypass Chamber Improvements

Neglia completed plans and specifications for the Phase I - Werimus Lane Bypass Chamber Improvements to address immediate public health and safety needs at the existing Werimus Lane sewage pumping station at this time. Construction of the bypass chamber system is substantially complete pending final electrical wiring and installation of pump floats. Neglia waiting on updated schedule from Sanzari for these remaining items so that testing of the bypass pumping system may be scheduled with the Borough.

4. Werimus Lane Pump Station Flood Resilient Improvements

Bids were opened on December 5, 2024 and reviewed by our office. Award recommendation package provided to Borough on 12/6/2024 recommending award of a contract to J.Fletcher Creamer and Sons for the amount of \$1,892,500.00 which was the lowest of four (4) bids submitted. Anticipated pre-construction to occur in January 2025 following award and execution of contracts so that Contractor can proceed with submittals to secure the necessary job materials.

5. Galaxy Gardens Civil Design and NJDEP Land Use Permitting

Project awarded to Applied Landscape for the total contract amount of \$2,753,123.00. Change Order No. 1 for Monument Area add-on and associated sitework in the amount of \$97,855.47 (3.55%) was approved by the Borough per Resolution No. 24-259. The sitework, grading, drainage, walkways, lighting, and landscaping improvements are substantially complete. The restroom building structure is substantially complete. Remaining items include the installation of the bandshell structure, pavilion structure, sign structure, and the CO #1 monument area work. Anticipated delivery of the bandshell, pavilion, and sign structure is the end of January 2025. Contractor is working toward final project completion for early Spring 2024 for a Borough ribbon cutting/opening to be scheduled and coordinated with the Borough.

6. Werimus Road/Old Mill/Woodcliff Avenue Traffic Signal Warrant Analysis

Neglia completed and provided the Traffic Signal Warrant Analysis to the Borough and County of Bergen for review. Neglia to coordinate a follow up meeting/conference with the Borough and County to discuss the report and next steps.

7. Campbell Avenue Paving Project NJDOT MA-2023 & Year 2023 Municipal Paving Project

The Borough of Woodcliff Lake received a grant in the amount of \$203,110.00 from the NJDOT for Campbell Avenue Paving Project as per the November 23, 2022 grant award letter. Project awarded to D&L Paving in the amount of \$551,105.11 for the Base Bid and Alternates A, B, C, and D for Campbell Avenue (NJDOT), Birchwood Road, Stacey Court, Renee Court, and Manhole Reconstructions. Pre-construction meeting was held on 6/6/2024. Birchwood Road drainage has been completed. Paving of Campbell Avenue, Stacey Court, Renee Court was completed. Birchwood Road has been temporarily restored with asphalt with final paving to occur in Spring 2025 following the settlement period of the drainage pipe trenching.

8. MS4 Stormwater Mapping & MS4 Assistance Grant, MS4 Updated MSWP

Neglia provided a proposal for MS4 Stormwater Mapping to address the latest NJDEP MS4 Regulations to the Borough. Neglia submitted the Tier A MS4 Grant application to NJDEP that was approved (\$25,000.00). Neglia is prepared to proceed with the MS4 Stormwater Mapping once our proposal is approved/authorized by the Borough. This mapping needs to be completed and submitted by January 1, 2026 for Borough MS4 Compliance. We need this proposal authorized asap in order to have sufficient time to complete the work for the January 1, 2026 NJDEP deadline as we estimate it will take approximately 8-12 months to complete the MS4 Stormwater Mapping.

Neglia provided a proposal to prepare a revised Municipal Stormwater Management Plan (MSWMP) as required by the NJDEP. The Borough's MSWP is from 2005 and the NJDEP requires the plan be updated at a minimum once every 10 years based on the most current Stormwater Control Ordinance (SCO).

9. Broadway Corridor Streetscape Improvement Project (NJDOT MA-2024)

The Borough of Woodcliff Lake received a grant in the amount of \$233,364.00 from the NJDOT for the Broadway Corridor Streetscape Improvements Project (Prospect to Campbell) as per the November 1, 2023 NJDOT grant award letter. Neglia has provided a proposal for the Engineering Design and Construction Management for review & execution by the Borough in order to stay on track with the

NJDOT MA 2024 award deadline of October 31, 2025. Neglia is prepared to proceed with the survey, design, and NJDOT PMRS pre-bid submissions once our proposal is approved/authorized by the Borough.

10. NJDOT FY2025 Grant – West Hill Road

Neglia provided preliminary engineer’s estimate and location mapping to Borough Grant Writer, Millenium Strategies for inclusions in their NJDOT grant submission for the Borough. Neglia can provide a proposal for survey, design, and construction management upon request and confirmation if a Grant was awarded.

11. Future Paving Projects & Road Selections

Preliminary Engineer’s estimates for Brookview Drive, Borough Hall Parking Lot and Drainage improvements, Evan Court, West Hill Road, and additional Manhole Reconstructions provided to Borough for review. Neglia can provide a formal proposal to the Borough for survey, design, and bid documents for the Year 2024-2025 Paving Program once final road selections are made and project scope confirmed.

12. Old Barn Site and Train Station Parking Lot (North Side)

Neglia is proceeding with Engineering Design, Bidding, Regulatory Permitting including an alternate bid to pave the south parking lot in accordance with our proposal. Site Plan was submitted to NJ Transit, Bergen County, and Veolia for review and coordination. Neglia submitted to the NJDEP Division of Land Use Submission on 11/27/2024 for work adjacent to the reservoir. The NJDEP Land Use application has a minimum 90-day review period. Neglia proceeding with final design plans and specifications to incorporate any comments and feedback from the above referenced review agencies so that the project is ready for bidding following receipt of the NJDEP permit and Borough approval of the same.

13. Woodcliff Lake Tennis Courts

Neglia understands that the Borough of Woodcliff Lake intends to pursue upgrades to the existing tennis court complex locate within Block 1401 Lot 5 in the Borough of Woodcliff Lake. We understand the Borough would like to reconstruct/reconfigure the existing (6) tennis courts with a new design to include pickleball courts, tennis courts, and a basketball court subject to review and approval by the Borough. As per a field visit and preliminary review and discussions with the Borough, we understand that there are concerns with drainage at the property and a portion of the Musquapsink Brook flows thru the northeast corner of the property per available mapping.

Neglia is proceeding with the survey and preliminary engineering concept plan in accordance with our proposal and Resolution 24-236. The existing conditions survey will be completed by the end of the month and we are working to complete the preliminary engineering concept plan and estimate by the end of January 2025.

14. Musquapsink Brook/Old Mill Road Area Wide Drainage Study

Neglia met with the Borough to review flood damage and erosion near the intersection of Old Mill Road, Werimus Road, and Woodcliff Avenue following the August 3 cloudburst storm event. Neglia provided a proposal for an Area Wide Drainage Study of the Musquapsink Brook centered at the Old

Mill Road/Werimus Road, and Woodcliff Avenue intersection to analysis the existing conditions both upstream and downstream of the existing culvert to provide recommendations for pro-active measures to improve drainage.

ORDINANCE NO. 24-17

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 178 ENTITLED "FIRE PREVENTION" OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODCLIFF LAKE, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODCLIFF LAKE IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Chapter 178, of the Code of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake sets forth all regulations regarding Fire Prevention within the Borough of Woodcliff Lake; and

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged.

Article II. Uniform Fire Code Enforcement.

ORDINANCE NO. 24-18

**AN ORDINANCE UPDATING CERTAIN FIRE PREVENTION PERMIT FEES OF THE BOROUGH
OF WOODCLIFF LAKE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODCLIFF LAKE, IN
THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake has recognized a need to
update certain fire prevention fees within the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake,

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AMENDMENT OF THE FAIR HOUSING ACT (FHA) AS PROPOSED BY THE NEW JERSEY INSTITUTE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT ATTORNEYS (NJILGA)

**RESOLUTION NO. 24-306
DECEMBER 16, 2024**

WHEREAS, the current standards embodied in the New Jersey Fair Housing Act (“FHA”) impose overwhelming burdens on municipalities as demonstrated by the fact that the Act calls for the imposition of a statewide affordable housing obligation of 84,690 just for Round 4 on municipalities that only issued 99,956 Certificates of Occupancy in the 2010-2020 period used to establish prospective need obligations for Round 4; and

WHEREAS, the imposition of excessive obligations does not create the realistic opportunity for the construction of more housing; and

WHEREAS, the imposition of excessive obligations disincentivizes municipalities to voluntarily comply – an overarching goal of all three branches of government; forces municipalities to overdevelop, thereby turning our Garden State into the garden apartment state; and spikes the obligations on taxpayers as municipal governments are left no choice but to commit to expensive compliance techniques in order to try to ameliorate the concerns of their communities with overdevelopment; and

WHEREAS, even handed justice requires that the obligations imposed by our laws must be realistic in order to justify imposing an obligation of constitutional dimension on municipalities to create a realistic opportunity for affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, the overwhelming impact of our current laws can be easily addressed merely by redefining the manner in which the regional need is calculated to be faithful to a principle embodied in the FHA despite its many changes over almost 40 years; and

WHEREAS, more specifically, the FHA has consistently defined the prospective need to include “a projection of housing needs based on development and growth which is *reasonably likely to occur* in a region or a municipality, as the case may be, as a result of actual determination of public and private entities” N.J.S.A.52:27D-304 (j); and

WHEREAS, the determination of the number of new units adjusted to remove tear down/rebuilds represents a far more solid foundation to project “development and growth which is *reasonably likely to occur*” than any other standard; and

WHEREAS, traditional 20 percent inclusionary zoning – the counterpart to exclusionary zoning-will only create a realistic opportunity for affordable housing if there is a sufficient market for the four market units needed to subsidize the fifth affordable unit; and

WHEREAS, the demand for market housing is essential to determining the creation of a realistic opportunity for affordable housing; and

WHEREAS a system that requires the construction of affordable housing in tandem with market housing ensures that as this state grows, it will grow with affordable housing without spawning the overdevelopment and spike in taxes that has led to an exodus of citizens leaving our state; and

WHEREAS, a standard that ensures that as our state grows it grows with a commensurate number of affordable housing units will put the doctrine on a trajectory that will avoid the doctrine from crumbling under its own weight by forcing municipalities to try to address overwhelming obligations; and

WHEREAS, fortunately, the New Jersey Institute of Local Government Attorneys has expressed its support for Legislation that defines the prospective need based upon “development and growth which is *reasonably likely to occur*”; and

WHEREAS, the redefinition of the affordable housing obligations of municipalities is not remarkable, but is rather a step in the continuous evolution of the doctrine since its inception in Mount Laurel I after which the obligation has been redefined multiple times; and

WHEREAS, our Supreme Court has emphasized that the issue of affordable housing is best left for the Legislature in that courts are ill equipped to deal with these issues and hence pledge to show great deference to the pronouncements of the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, this pledge for deference bodes well for any redefinition of the obligation-particularly one rooted in reality and designed to ensure that as municipalities grow with market housing, they grow with affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, for the above reasons, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake has determined that the Borough of Woodcliff Lake's prospective need, and the prospective need for all New Jersey municipalities for the fourth round and all future rounds of affordable housing obligations, should be calculated using NJILGA's proposed CO-based methodology rather than the current FHA methodology based on "household change," and that NJILGA's proposed FHA amendment should be enacted by the New Jersey legislature as soon as possible;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake, in the County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, that the New Jersey legislature is hereby requested to enact the amendment to the Fair Housing Act that has been recommended by the New Jersey Institute of Local Government Attorneys and is attached hereto; and

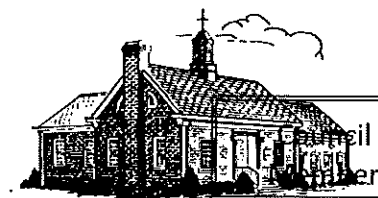

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WITHDRAWAL FROM THE PASCACK JOINT MUNICIPAL COURT

RESOLUTION NO. 24-312 DECEMBER 16, 2024

WHEREAS, on or about February 8, 2011, the Borough of Woodcliff Lake (“Woodcliff Lake”) entered into a Shared Services Agreement (“SSA”) with the Borough of Montvale (“Montvale”) and the Borough of Park Ridge (“Park Ridge”), collectively, the Municipalities, which established the Pascack Joint Municipal Court (“Joint Court”) pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1(b); and

WHEREAS, prior to the establishment of the Joint Court, the Municipalities each maintained separate municipal courts; and

WHEREAS, prior to the establishment of the Joint Court, the Municipalities conducted a mutually-supported study of the feasibility of either a joint municipal court pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1 or a shared municipal court pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1(c); and

WHEREAS, the Municipalities ultimately determined it to be in their best interest to establish a joint municipal court; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1 et. seq. authorizes the formation of a joint court provided an agreement is entered into by all of the Municipalities, and provided that such Agreement is approved by and filed with the State of New Jersey Administrative Office of Courts and the Assignment Judge of the Bergen County Superior Court; and

WHEREAS, the SSA was established in accord with the Uniform Shared Services and

Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et. seq. and designated Montvale as the lead agency; and

WHEREAS, the SSA was renewed in or about July 2023 by the Municipalities with substantially similar terms as the SSA of 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Montvale has served the Borough of Woodcliff Lake with a notice to withdraw from the Joint Court; and

WHEREAS, for this and other reasons, Woodcliff Lake has determined that it may no longer be in its best interest to continue its membership in the Joint Court and to seek other alternatives; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary to provide notice to withdraw from the Joint Court as provided for in Sec. III(C) of the 2023 SSA prior to the effective withdrawal date; and

WHEREAS, upon its withdrawal from the Joint Court, Woodcliff Lake is agreeable to continue to explore other options for a Joint Court and/or shared municipal court along with Montvale and/or Park Ridge or other municipalities or to resume operating as a single Municipal Court.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, that the withdrawal from the Pascack Joint Municipal Court for the reasons stated herein, be and is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Attorney shall serve a written notice to the Joint Court and the Municipalities of its intention to withdraw from the Joint Court effective January 1, 2026 and that such notice be delivered to the Joint Court and the Municipalities on or before December 31, 2024; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, nothing herein shall foreclose or prevent Woodcliff Lake from negotiating with the Municipalities regarding the continuation of the Joint Court and/or the establishment of a shared municipal court with any other municipality or such other agreement as may be in the best interests of Woodcliff Lake or the Municipalities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is subject to consultation with the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Park Ridge.
