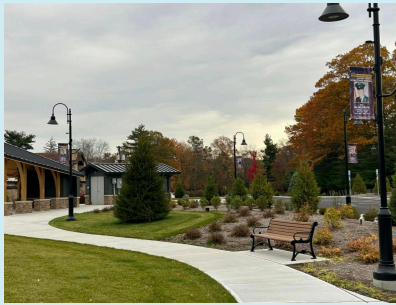

A secure lockbox containing a key to your home is discreetly installed on your property and is accessible only by the police department. This allows emergency responders to enter your home without delay or property damage when immediate assistance is needed.



### 🌲 Woodcliff Lake Has Over 5,400 Public Trees

Did you know that Woodcliff Lake has more than 5,400 public trees located along borough streets and in key public spaces?

Our borough-wide tree inventory, completed in December 2024 by certified arborists, provides valuable information that helps guide responsible tree care and long-term planning.

Key Findings

- Over 88% of trees are in good or fair health, showing strong structure and vitality.
- The borough has 147 distinct tree species.
- No single species makes up more than 8% of the total population, helping protect the tree canopy from pests and disease.

This diversity strengthens our ecosystem and supports birds, pollinators, and local wildlife while preserving the natural beauty of Woodcliff Lake.

## Department of Public Works

The Borough of Woodcliff Lake DPW is gearing up for road repairs

Warm weather means street paving and pothole resurfacing will begin across town.




**Who Handles What:**

- Woodcliff Lake DPW → Borough-owned streets
- Bergen County → County roads
- NJ DOT → State highways

- Continued investment and allocation in budget to fix borough roads
- Continued improvements to roadway safety and conditions

With the arrival of warmer weather, the Borough's Department of Public Works is preparing for seasonal roadway maintenance throughout the community. This time of year typically marks the start of street paving projects and pothole resurfacing as crews begin addressing areas impacted by winter weather and normal wear.

Road maintenance in town is managed by several different agencies depending on the roadway. Borough-owned streets are maintained by the local DPW, while county roads fall under the responsibility of Bergen County and state highways are handled by the New Jersey Department of Transportation. Each agency schedules its own work and improvements accordingly.

Residents may notice roadway work occurring in different areas as part of ongoing efforts to maintain safe and reliable travel throughout the borough. The municipal budget continues to prioritize investment in roadway maintenance, helping ensure borough streets remain in good condition and continue to improve over time.

The Department of Public Works remains committed to keeping local roads safe, smooth, and well-maintained for residents, visitors, and commuters alike.

**Woodcliff Lake Curb Side Collection Reminder**  
**TRASH WILL NOW BE PICKED UP CURBSIDE**

Residents can now place a total of 5 containers and/or items for trash pick-up. Trash should be placed in 40-gallon trash cans.



OR

There is a 50lb weight limit on trash and non-trash items and can include items such as lamps, rugs, chairs, and other household items.

### 2026 Sanitation & Recycling Updates

As of February 1, 2026, Sterling Carting expanded its services and are now collecting the Borough's weekly garbage in addition to the weekly recycling.


#### Garbage Collection Reminders

- Limit of 5 cans/items per weekly garbage collection with a 50lb weight limit per can


- Containers must be 40 gallons or less and not designed for automated trucks
- Non-trash items must weigh less than 50 pounds per item and can include items such as lamps, rugs, chairs, and other household items.
- It cannot include recyclables or white metal items, such as appliances, or items greater than 50 pounds.
- All materials must be placed curbside by 6:00 AM on collection days
- Empty containers must be removed from the curb by 8:00 PM
- Curbside Collection Required -All garbage must now be placed curbside. Drive-up service is permanently discontinued.

#### Recycling Guidelines

- Recycling must be placed in a container — plastic bags are not permitted
- Curbside recycling may be co-mingled according to the published schedule
- At the Ecology Center, recycling must be separated
- Vehicles are required to have visible for entry
- No scavenging, no trailers, no commercial vehicles, and no walk-ins

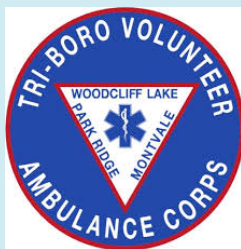

4. Layer the lemon curd over the graham crumbs, top with meringue, and lightly toast with a kitchen torch.
5. Chill briefly and enjoy!
