Looking forward to a great party! Price to come at a later date.



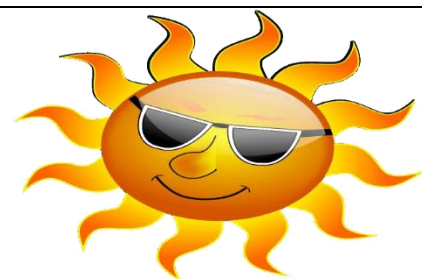
WLSA Book Club is looking for new members. It is a great opportunity to socialize, read interesting books and have an opportunity to discuss those books.
