December 31st we welcomed 2025 at the Tice Senior Center. This has become a tradition and something that our seniors look forward to.



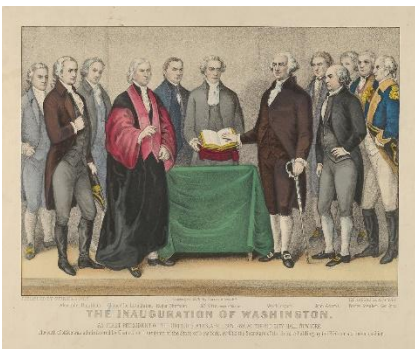

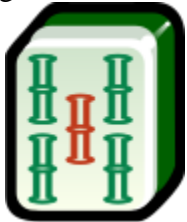
